

HENRY COUNTY COMMISSION
WORK SESSION
SEPTEMBER 11, 2024
1:00 P.M.

The Henry County Commission held a Special Called Meeting Wednesday, September 11, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. The following members were in attendance: Chairman David Money, and Commissioners Benton Beasley, John Ralph Saunders, Jason Hudspeth, Henry Grimsley and Gregory Reynolds. Also present were Chris Champion, Dawn Shirley, Ashley Eiland, Sheriff Blankenship, and Lt. Behringer.

Chairman Money stated this meeting was called to discuss Budgets, Personnel Policy, and the vacated Camp Sayla facility.

Chris Champion reviewed the amended budgets. The Road department amended budget will include \$100,000 more to the loan on dump trucks. The FY25 budget was previously discussed at the Budget Workshop. Both budgets will be presented at the Commission meeting on 9/19/24 for approval.

John Gunn, Diane Ealey, and Laura Arnold were present to present their plan for the vacated Camp Sayla facility. If approved the plan will be for "Home," a new residential treatment center.

The county's participation in the employee retiree insurance was discussed. Chairman Money recommended capping the monthly amount the county contributes and the years of employment to qualify for the county's contributions. The changes would only affect future retirees and not those already in the program.

Chairman Money recommended a meal reimbursement policy for employees attending training conferences. There is no current policy in place.

Chris Champion and Matt Hatcher updated the commission on fencing for the new impound yard as well as a service contract for the HVAC at the Courthouse and Herndon building.

With no further business, meeting adjourned at 2:36 p.m.
